- Living wages are paid
- Working hours are not excessive
- No discrimination is practiced
- Regular employment is provided
- No harsh or inhumane treatment is allowed

We comply with this, however, to drive it down the supply chain is more complex. We achieve this by using reputable suppliers who have policies in place and are diligent in their approach to the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Our purchasing department are fully aware of the act and ensure that all suppliers are taking steps to meet their ethical responsibilities.
